The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA)

HIPAA is the acronym for the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996. The Department of Health and Human Services is required to establish national standards for electronic health care transactions, national identifiers for providers, health plans, and employers, and the security and privacy of patient health data. B.I.S. Community Clinic is required by law and regulation to protect the privacy of your medical information, to provide you with notice of its privacy practices with respect to protected health information, and to abide by the terms of the notice of privacy practices in effect.
